July 25-Aug. 5, 2009, Professional Intensive I - \$2,400.

August 5-14, 2009, Professional Intensive II - \$2,000.

Full payment of the fee minus the deposit is required by June 1st.

For legitimate reasons, all payments, minus a cancellation fee of \$150, are refundable up to four weeks before the start of TCA.

Included: tuition, room (double or triple w/ private bath; single is an additional \$800), food and wine, laundry, excursions & museums, use of studios, pool and tennis court, transfer from/to Florence train station or airport on opening and closing days (please send travel details when available), and basic studio art supplies.

Not included: Travel to and from Florence, accident & health insurance, paints and brushes. (TCA students get a discount at the art supply store Zecchi in Florence.)
